Staff Excellence

Our teacher to child ratio exceeds NYS licensing standards in every age group to allow for high quality care and education. We provide ongoing training and professional development for our staff – ensuring the best possible programs for our children. In 2012, toddler teacher Vanessa Cicchelli received national recognition! She was a recipient of the Terri Lynne Lokoff/ Children's TYLENOL® National Child Care Teacher Award, given by The Terri Lynne Lokoff Child Care Foundation. The foundation, named for Ms. Lokoff, a child care teacher whose life was tragically cut short, is dedicated to improving early care and education in America. The award was attached to a \$1,000 gift to Vanessa and her classroom.

Concluding our 40th anniversary, we were able to assess and reflect on our mission, growth and strategic goals in 2012. One thing is clear, your generous investments made all the difference in what we have done and what we hope to do for the children and families at MKCCC.

We are so proud of our many accomplishments and efforts that continue to make MKCCC the best possible choice for early care and education in Northern Westchester. Our amazing teachers, under the direction of Dawn Meyerski, are at the center of it all! And of course we are so grateful for our dedicated and wonderful administrative and kitchen staff who ensure all runs smoothly (and deliciously!) day in and day out!

MKCCC began 2012 by receiving NAEYC accreditation. Since 1985, The National Association for the Education of Young Children's national, voluntary accreditation system has set professional standards for early childhood education programs and helped families identify high-quality programs for their young children. MKCCC has worked hard to attain NAEYC accreditation, and we are extremely proud of our achievement!

Last year, we once again welcomed many volunteers at MKCCC who contributed countless hours inside and out. Our Feed Me Fresh garden and nutrition program continues to take center stage and the great benefits that are realized for both children and adults as a result of this initiative. We are also very grateful for our partnership with My Second Home, a program of Family Services of Westchester for the JEWEL intergenerational program. JEWEL was also chosen in 2012 to participate in the New York State Intergenerational Network (Westchester Chapter) conference where we highlighted the benefits of the Feed Me Fresh Program for children and older adults. Painting with pine cones in the fall, making bird feeders in the winter, planting seeds in the spring and playing in the water in the summer – what a year our children and seniors had!

In May, MKCCC raised more than \$50,000 during its Spring Challenge. Funds raised through the challenge were allocated toward the Center's Scholarship Program. In June, more than 250 adults and children enjoyed a MKCCC benefit performance by Sarah Lee Guthrie and Johnny Irion, and September featured our incredibly successful 8th Annual Feed Me Fresh: An Edible Evening.

On behalf of the children, families and staff of MKCCC, we would like to extend a very heartfelt thank-you to David Griff, our Board President, for his outstanding leadership and to the dedicated members of the Board of Directors. We remain ever grateful to our many friends, volunteers, donors, foundations and community organizations who help continue our mission and make MKCCC the most vibrant and engaged Center it can possibly be!

Innovative Programs

In addition to caring for and nurturing infants (3 months to 18 months), toddlers (18 months to 3 years) and prekindergarten children (3 years to 5 years), the Center gives all children the educational opportunities they need to ensure their readiness for school. School age children also have access to a before-school program (through which children are transported by bus to the Bedford Central schools) and an after-school program for children who are dropped off in the afternoon. These programs are critical for working parents who require extended care for their children outside of regular school hours. Summer camp programs begin at the end of June and run through the end of August. Children are engaged in farming and gardening, swimming, creative arts activities and field trips among other adventures.

MKCCC embraces the needs of all children, including those with developmental delays. The Center works closely with the Children's School for Early Development, Early Intervention programs and the local school districts to identify and support any child in need of special services.

Feed Me Fresh

Feed Me Fresh is MKCCC's year round garden to table nutrition program which is a hands-on approach to healthy eating and nutrition education. With the help of a team of nutritionists, farmers and chefs, MKCCC has created a curriculum that builds a natural appreciation for fresh, whole food. Breakfast, hot lunch and snacks are prepared for all our children from scratch in our own Feed Me Fresh kitchen each day. The kitchen staff purchases as much local and organic food as possible while using ingredients from the children's gardens. In the spring, for the first time ever, we transplanted seeds that germinated during the winter in our Greenhouse, into our gardens. In 2012, MKCCC welcomed Culinary Institute of America graduate Lisa Koschak to our full-time kitchen staff. Lisa, who has worked at MKCCC part-time since December 2010, previously worked at such restaurants as An American Place and Chanterelle, as well as at The Beekman Arms in Rhinebeck.



JEWEL

Our award-winning JEWEL program joins our young children with older adults from **Family Services of Westchester's** My Second Home (MSH), our on-site neighbors. JEWEL is the first shared-site, intergenerational program of its kind in Westchester County. Every day our children and the "grandmas" and "grandpas" from MSH come together in small groups. Whether they are drumming, dancing, creating great works of art, sharing stories or just sharing breakfast together, these daily interactions between the two age groups are filled with fun, acceptance, and mutual respect. In 2012, JEWEL was chosen to participate in the New York State Intergenerational Network (Westchester Chapter) conference. The program centered on the Feed Me Fresh program at MKCCC.



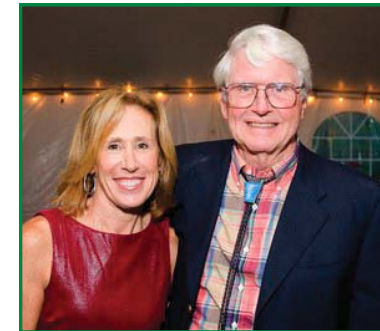
Professional Practice

In 2012, MKCCC earned accreditation from the National Association for the Education of Young Children, a national, voluntary accreditation system that sets professional standards for early childhood education programs and helps families identify high-quality programs for their young children.

FIVE STARS!! MKCCC continues to participate in QUALITYstarsNY, New York State's quality rating and improvement system designed for all types of early childhood programs. Using 'star ratings' (one to five stars), QUALITYstarsNY is designed to help parents access the best possible care for their child. It also helps our teachers strengthen their programs while improving and communicating the quality of care we provide at the Center. As a participant, MKCCC receives a personalized improvement roadmap which includes training and financial assistance to help achieve a top rating.

Feed Me Fresh Annual Gala

More than 300 people gathered for MKCCC's Eighth Annual **Feed Me Fresh: An Edible Evening**, on Saturday, September 22nd at **Eric Hadar's** beautiful Ivanna Farms located in Bedford Corners, NY. Guests enjoyed the breezy autumn evening as they dabbled in tastings from more than 20 of Westchester's most notable restaurants and farms. Proceeds from the event were used to provide invaluable need-based scholarship assistance to children enrolled at MKCCC. Many of our parents were actively involved in this year's benefit honoring **Frances and Isidoro Albanese** of Frannie's Goodie Shop and Bellizzi and MKCCC Board Member **Curtis Beusman**.



MKCCC Gives Back

MKCCC recognizes the importance of supporting community members in need. In November, MKCCC launched a relief drive in the aftermath of Superstorm Sandy. Thanks to the generosity of our families, neighbors and communities, we distributed more than 3,000 diapers and 4,000 baby wipes, along with dozens of blankets and towels, many containers of formula, baby food, non-perishable food, clothes, batteries and first-aid supplies to the victims that live in the hardest-hit parts of Coney Island, The Rockaways and Oceanside, NY. It was truly a remarkable effort.



Community Partners

MKCCC hosts a vibrant and active volunteer initiative. Over 100 individuals play a crucial role in the success of MKCCC programs each year, enriching the lives of our children and providing invaluable support for our staff. Whether it's a high school student fulfilling a community service goal, or local corporate employees offering their expertise, we greatly appreciate the time and talent of all who volunteer.



Among many examples, in June, we welcomed Mount Kisco's **Ben & Jerry's Scoop Shop** employees who dedicating an entire afternoon to a variety of activities with the children. In October, more than 35 local employees of **Endurance Specialty Holdings Ltd.** pitched in - as part of the Insurance Industry Charitable Foundation's Week of Giving - by caring for the grounds, painting, and working in the classroom with the Center's children. In November, local volunteers from **IBM** helped expand the Center's environmental focus by assessing the practices of the Center. IBM volunteers worked with children and staff in discussing environmental impacts to be made in the classroom and in the community. The children planted terrariums from recycled 2 liter soda bottles with plants donated by **Michael's Garden Gate Nursery**. Our school-

age children have been fortunate to spend their summers working at **Amawalk Farm** and getting a hands-on experience about the life of a farmer and supporting our Feed Me Fresh curriculum. In the fall, **Northern Westchester Hospital** held a flu clinic at MKCCC for our families. In December, the **Junior League of Northern Westchester** and families in our community provided holiday packages for our families who otherwise might have gone without. **Whalen's Moving and Storage, Chappaqua Transportation** along with the **Yorktown High School** Varsity Hockey Team helped deliver those gifts.



Scholarships

The cornerstone of our mission is to provide affordable care to all children. 90 children received scholarship assistance in 2012, 16 more than in the previous year. We continue to advocate for government funding on behalf of our families with the greatest financial need. A press conference held on September 28th, at MKCCC addressed Westchester County Executive Robert P. Astorino's decision to raise the parent share for child care subsidies and also freeze the number of Title XX day care slots. MKCCC serves 160 children ages 3 months to 11 years of age, and over half of the families need some form of tuition assistance. 25% of those families depend on County child care subsidies. MKCCC relies on multiple sources of funding to operate our programs. In the last two years, as government funding has decreased, our need for scholarship support has increased 30% over the past 2 years.

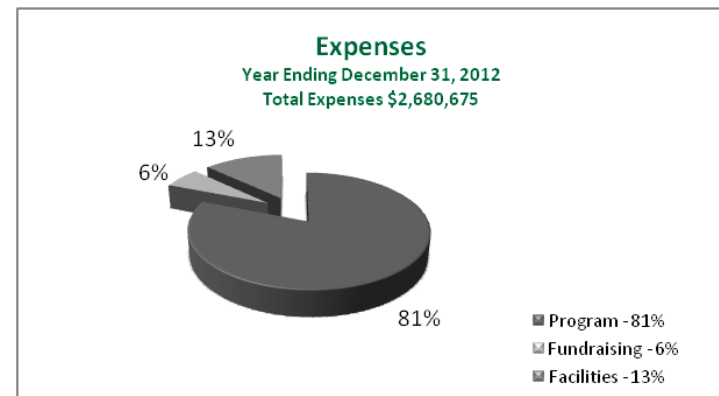
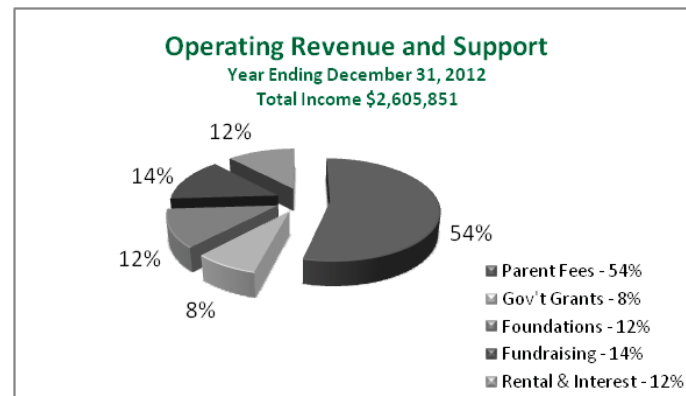

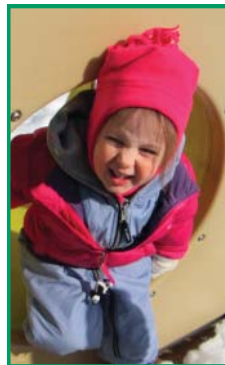
