environment through innovative and developmentally appropriate programming

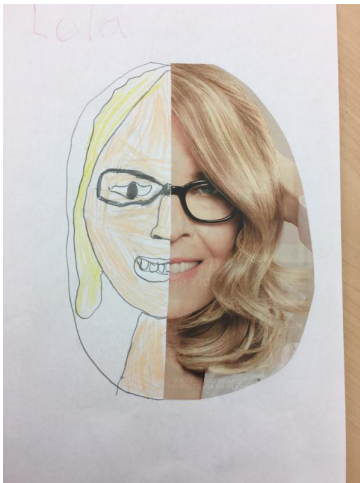

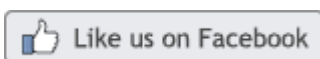
