Having operated in the Village of Mount Kisco for over fifty years, we have proudly earned our place as an institution within the community. Our roots and relationships are deep, and we are very grateful for the generous support of the community. However, we are mindful to never rest on past success and know that to continue to do the best for the children of MKCCC we must always be evolving.

Recently, we noticed that our mission statement didn't fully reflect how our organization has evolved through the years and determined it needed some edits. We are excited to share our revised statement in this year's report. The new statement better reflects the multifaceted work done at the Center, emphasizing our support of the whole family, and better encapsulating our focus on equitable access. Whether it's navigating forms for subsidy reimbursements or handling the loss of a family pet, our staff supports our families so that they can thrive and partners with other organizations to ensure all their needs are met. We operate as a nonprofit so that we can provide access to families regardless of their ability to pay. And because every child deserves the opportunity to live to their greatest potential, we also provide leadership in the community to raise awareness of the challenges facing families and child care providers in order to build systemic solutions for equitable access for all children. It has been a natural evolution of our work, and we are happy to have it better reflected in our mission.

This year we also worked on many initiatives to keep the Center innovative and state-of-art. We laid the groundwork, secured funding, and broke ground on brand new playgrounds for our toddler and pre-school classrooms. And, after much research, we concluded that we needed to pursue STEM programming in our Pre-K classrooms. We found an incredible partner with STEM Alliance and have secured funding to make our Pre-K STEM program a reality. We also re-invigorated our signature Feed Me Fresh seed-to-table nutrition program, bringing back recipes and cooking after a COVID induced hiatus.

Also true to our age, we lost some great friends that had profoundly shaped MKCCC through the years and whose dedication made so much possible. We are happy to honor them in this year's report. At the end of the day, it is those that support us with their creative ideas, time, friendship, laughter, and donations that make the work of MKCCC possible, and we will miss our friends greatly.

We are excited for what's to come in 2023-2024 and would like to welcome our friends and supporters to come in and take tour. It always warms our hearts to connect with you here at the Center and show you how we continue to grow.

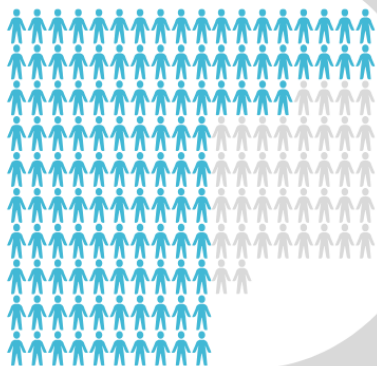

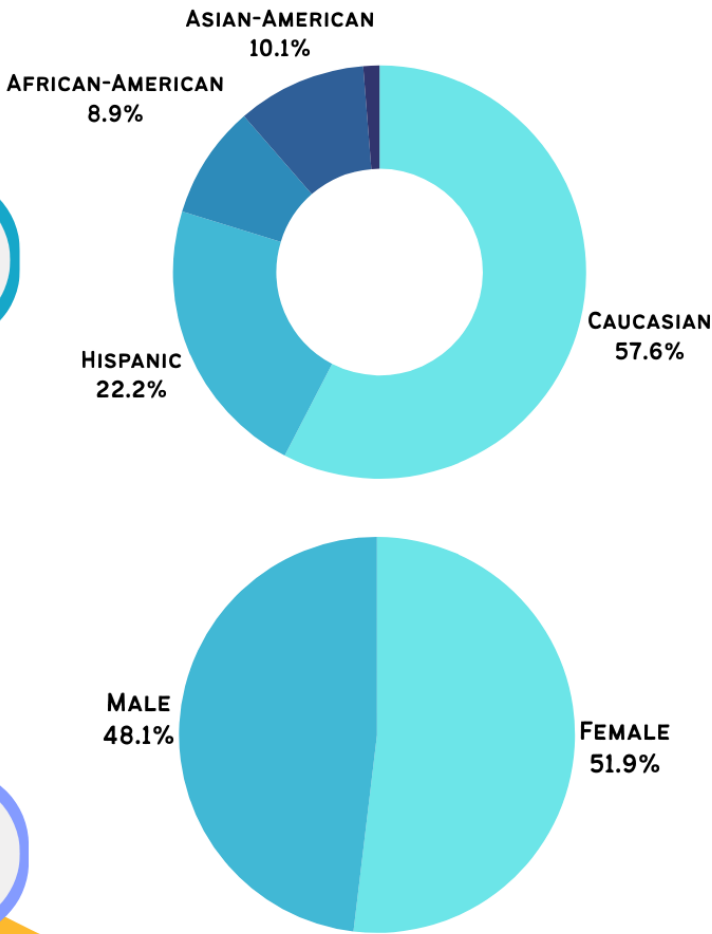

## WHY IT MATTERS

Child care for families of any income level-- but most especially low and moderate income levels-- has never been more scarce. Since the pandemic, New York's child care workforce has shrunk by 42%, resulting in centers with empty classrooms, overflowing waitlists, and staff that is overworked and undercompensated. Many centers have had to close altogether, furthering the burden on centers that are barely staying afloat. Coupled with the skyrocketing inflation rate, raising the cost of living as well as the cost of care, families that are able to find child care still face the challenge of affording it. The need for accessible, affordable, high quality care for all is greater than ever.

Since 1971, the MKCCC Scholarship Fund has provided an avenue to high quality child care and early education to families who would not otherwise have access to it. Every day at MKCCC, children of all backgrounds, abilities, and socio-economic statuses come together to learn and grow, from both our incredible teaching staff and from each other. MKCCC works to bridge the gap between families who are able to afford the rising cost of child care and those who cannot, while also providing care that considers the individual needs of each child for the most nurturing care possible. This includes actively advocating for child care legislation, providing in house guidance and support, and partnering with local schools and organizations in order to provide special services. MKCCC works tirelessly so that our families know that their children are in a place dedicated to meeting each child's individual needs and celebrates all of their successes.



# '22-'23 HIGHLIGHTS



## HOLIDAY BREAKFASTS RETURN

In December 2022, the Center was holly jolly and filled with joy as the highly anticipated Holiday Breakfasts made their return! Children and parents filled the gross motor room to the brim with laughter and chatter as new parents met and old parents reunited post-covid. We are thrilled that this holiday staple could finally come back!



## LITERACY ADVENTURES RETURN

Following the Holiday Breakfasts, Literacy Adventures also finally returned to MKCCC. Lead by Ms. Vanessa and Ms. Jenny, the featured story was "Love is All Around the World", a sweet story about the different kinds of love present all around us, in honor of Valentine's Day. Storytime was followed with a craft where children and parents alike rolled up their sleeves and broke out the glue sticks and got to work. This Literacy Adventure was the first of many in 2023 and we can't wait for even more in 2024!



## ADVOCACY WINS

In February, much of the month was dedicated to advocacy for child care and thanks to the hard work of advocates-- including many county and state representatives, families, local child care advocates, and MKCCC's Executive Director, Dawn Meyerski-- that work paid off. The most notable win of 2023 was the increase in eligibility for families for both Department of Social Service and Westchester Works subsidies.



## MKCCC'S SUMMER FARM STAND

MKCCC Campers hosted an especially successful farm stand this past summer, thanks to their hard work growing, making the various wares, and creating new signage each week. After opening the stand every Wednesday for 8 weeks without fail, campers raised over \$200! At the end of the summer, the camp made the collective decision to donate their profits to the Interfaith Food Pantry and the Maria Ferrari Children's Hospital.

## FIELD DAY FUN

This past summer, MKCCC hosted its first Field Day, thanks to the amazing coordination of the Cafaldo family! It was a perfect summer day as campers competed in the bean bag toss, relay races, and finally the water bucket challenge, testing their aim, balance, teamwork, and ability to have fun!



## PLAYGROUND PROJECT KICKS OFF

Many exciting projects were in the works in 2023. At the end of the 2023 fiscal year, we were thrilled to kick off our playground project following months and months of planning. At the end of August, the old Pre-K and toddler playgrounds were torn up and we kicked off the beginning of the following fiscal year by building our brand new playgrounds!



## STEM PROGRAMMING

This year, STEM programming via The STEM Alliance was introduced to the MKCCC curriculum! Our budding scientists are learning new ways to explore and see the world while conducting experiments that teach them about concepts like buoyancy, structural integrity, potential energy through building rockets and catapults, floating figures on rafts, and building popsicle stick houses that stand up against blow dryer windstorms. Needless to say, the program has been a huge success.



## QUALITY STARS RATING-- 5 STARS

MKCCC recently underwent annual recertification for Quality Stars NY, a system that rates child care centers from 1 to 5 stars based on how they meet NY State requirements for child care. We are pleased to say that thanks to the incredible work of all our staff, we have achieved a 5 STAR RATING, among only a handful of other centers in NYS at the top of the rankings.





# PROGRAMS



Mount Kisco Child Care Center provides child care and early education for ages 3 months to 11 years. At MKCCC we go well beyond the traditional requirements — our programs and tools help teachers create individualized learning and care plans for every child. Progress and updates are available each day for families to ensure home / school continuity is in place for our little learners.

In our infant rooms, we create a warm, nurturing environment that acts as an extension of our infants' homes. Infants are provided with daily opportunities that encourage social and emotional development, speech and language, cognitive growth, and fine and gross motor development through group and independent activities. We even use basic American Sign Language to provide avenues of communication to our youngest children.

Toddlers love to explore the world around them. The toddler rooms are designed to allow children to use all of their senses to learn and grow. Toddlers are engaged in activities and experiences designed to meet their emerging skills in language, socialization and personal autonomy. In addition, the toddlers have their own playground, a place where they can run, jump, climb, and develop those large motor skills as well.

Our preschool is a mixed 3, 4, and 5 year- old age group. We think it makes sense to teach children developmentally rather than chronologically. Each child comes in with different experiences and skill sets. Lesson plans are written to prepare children for Kindergarten in ways that are play based and developmentally appropriate. We use the Creative Curriculum, which is a child-initiated curriculum. Children learn best when they are learning about the things that they are interested in. Lesson plans cover all content areas necessary for school success; literacy, math, science, and social studies.

Our school age program consists of our before and after school programs. Both programs provide a place where students can get homework help and prepare for or unwind from the day while they socialize with friends and play games. MKCCC offers a full-day, 8 week summer camp program for Kindergarten through 5th grade. Every day is a new day filled with fun in the sun while also continuing each child's development. We provide a variety of programming that every child can find an interest in from karate, dance classes, and daily trips to the local pool, to STEM endeavors like roller coaster and robot building. The Feed Me Fresh program thrives during summer camp, with new garden projects every day. Our camper-run farm stand teaches campers how to manage a farm stand, advertise, and the importance of supporting their community when they donate their profits to a local organization of their choice at the end of the summer.

# FEED ME FRESH PROGRAM

## PROVIDING GARDEN EDUCATION FOR MORE THAN 20 YEARS

Developed in consultation with nutritionists, teachers, local farmers, and restaurants, Feed Me Fresh (FMF) is an innovative, year round, garden-to-table food service and nutrition education program. FMF pairs hands-on gardening units with cooking classes based on seasonal offerings from our playground garden beds, and includes healthy meals and snacks from our in-house FMF Food Service team. Each year, close to 200 MKCCC children learn about healthy eating through exposure to fresh foods they get to grow themselves. For some of our at-risk families, the program provides nutrient dense food they might otherwise not have access to. In addition, it builds life-long healthy eating habits for all the children at MKCCC.

Our 2022-23 gardens were abundant with all of our favorites like lettuce, kale, snap peas, herbs, carrots, potatoes, and strawberries-- we were even able to harvest a couple of ears of corn! Most notably at the end of 2022, the cooking portion of Feed Me Fresh returned to our classrooms. Some of our favorite recipes in the last year have included strawberry smoothies, spring-time kale salad, tomato herb bruschetta, pumpkin bread, and Asian icebox pickles.

MKCCC is more than just a home away from home for many of our families. We are the safety net that helps to keep families thriving in this community. One of our families has been part of the Center for 8 years. The mom is a single mom who works in a minimum wage job and has two young children. They live in a one room apartment with a shared kitchen space. Cooking can be a challenge. While at the Center, we make certain that the children eat plenty of healthy foods for breakfast and lunch and send extra food home as often as possible. We were also happy to collect holiday gifts for the children, and Mom was mindful to choose the ones that could work in their space. While not ideal, she stays in this apartment because of its location which provides access to public transportation and is within walking distance to local stores, the school and the Center. Without a car, she makes the necessary choices for her family. It is our mission at MKCCC to meet families where they are. We make sure that these children have a safe place to learn and grow so that Mom can go to work and the entire family can thrive thanks to the support of the Center.

MKCCC seeks to provide stability for the whole family. At the beginning of this year, we welcomed a mother and her newborn child to the Center. Her husband passed shortly before the baby was born and having no job herself, was no longer able to afford housing, staying on friends' couches while caring for her newborn. Through the Scholarship Program and the Baby Steps Forward program, we were able to admit her child to the infant program, which allowed mom the peace of mind and time to find a job and housing for her family.

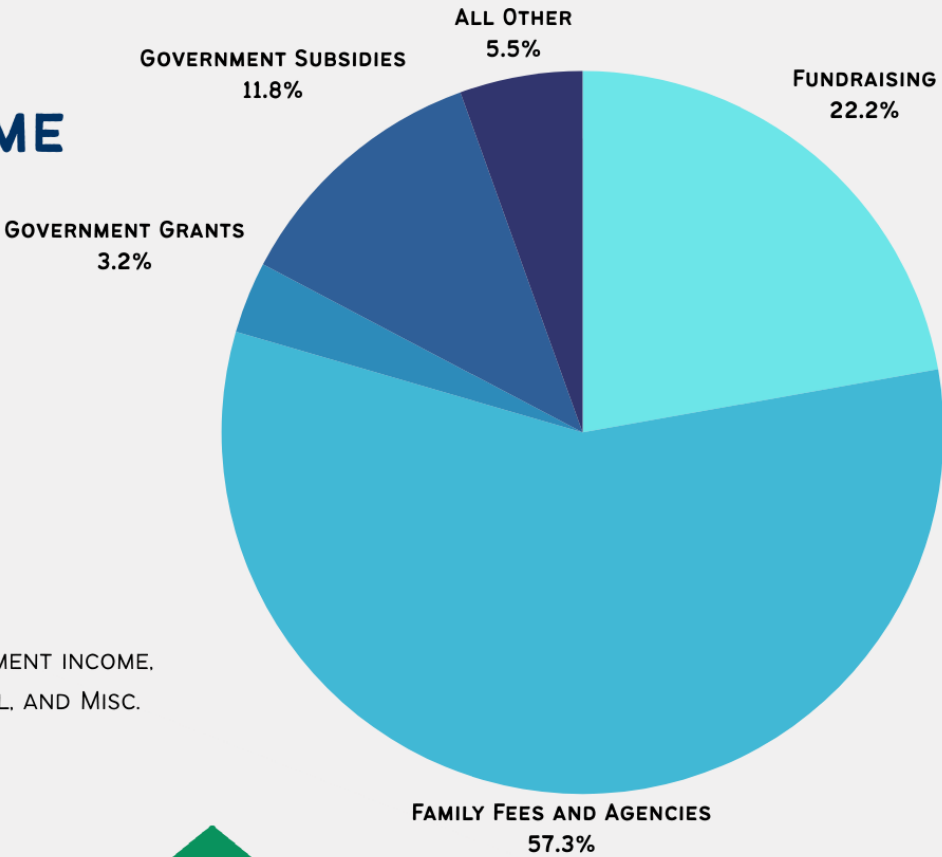

TOTAL INCOME: \$3,527,000



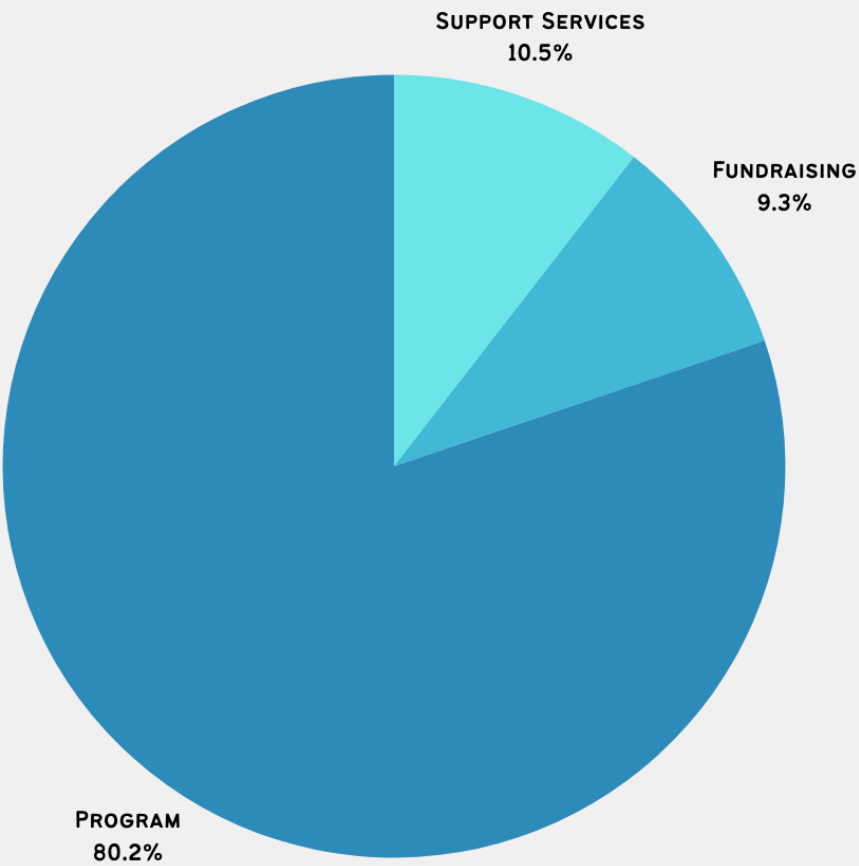

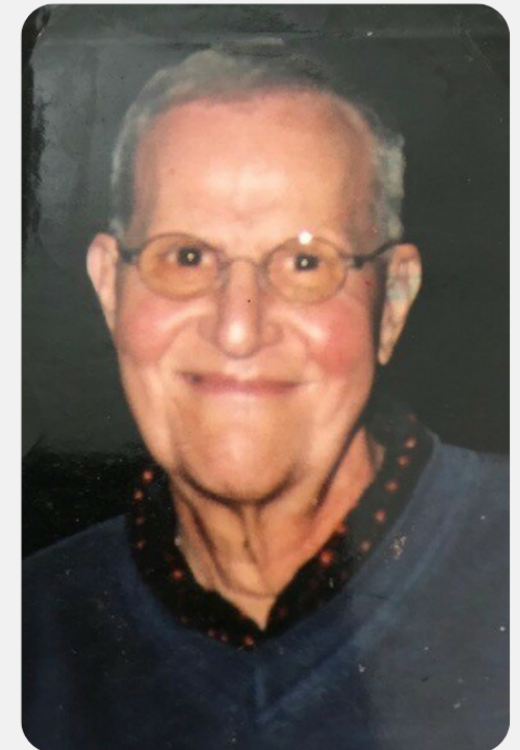
## DR. BENEDICT CATERINICCHIO
